
Netherlands: waterproof jackets turning into sleeping bags, businessman Timmer's gift to the homeless

They are called "sheltersuits" and are waterproof jackets made of a very warm material that can turn into equally warm and waterproof sleeping bags. They were invented in 2014 by Bas Timmer, who is now 30; he makes them from textile leftovers or waste; he has them sewn by Syrian refugees or people who live on the margins of society and who find their place again through work.
