Belarus: national strike, the country stops. Tsikhanouskaya, "determined to end dictatorship"

After yet another Sunday of protests where thousands of Belarusian citizens took to the streets with police trying to disperse them (hundreds of arbitrary arrests were reported on social media), the strike called by opposition leader Sviatlana Tsikhanouskaya has started today. This comes after yesterday's expiration of the ultimatum to meet the three requests put forward by Tsikhanouskaya, namely "Lukashenko's resignation; stopping violence; and releasing political prisoners".
