
Sweden: church vandalised in Göteborg. Card. Arborelius, news that gives “pain and dismay”

The names of those who entered the Church of Christ the King in Göteborg (Sweden) on Friday 13th November and damaged it are not known yet. A week earlier, the cross had already been stolen from the altar, but in the second raid the altar cloth was ripped out, the ambo and the chair were overturned and thrown off the presbytery. A side chapel and several other items, such as the books of chants and the votive candles for the dead, were damaged as well. According to the parish priest, don Tobias Unnerstål, this is “intentional destruction” with “symbolic” gestures that are suggestive of “rage against the Church”.
